General Rules and Regulations

- 1) Only those Students who studied under West Bengal Council of H.S. Education / C.B.S.E / I.S.C / National Institute of Open Schooling / Rabindra Mukta Vidyalaya and other recognized Boards as approved by University of Calcutta are eligible to fill up the application form directly from the College Website.
- **2)** Dates and Time of Admission would be strictly followed. No extension of date and time will be specially granted to anyone.
- 3) Candidates can apply for all eligible courses by paying <u>One-Time Payment</u> of <u>Application Fee Rs. 300/-</u> through <u>On-Line Payment System</u> or <u>Off-line Payment (Bank Challan) System</u>. For <u>Offline Payment Mode</u>, <u>E-Challan</u> will be generated after the submission of Application form and it will be submitted to the <u>Designated Bank with payment</u>. The <u>Designated Bank and Branch is Axis Bank</u>, <u>Garia Branch</u>. Do not pay in other branch. Offline payment made in other Branch of Axis Bank is not considerable in anyway. The College Authority will be not responsible for payment elsewhere.
- *4)* Application Forms will not be considered valid unless payment (On-line/Off-line) is made to the Bank.

Admission Qualifications

1. A candidate who has passed the Higher Secondary (10 + 2) or its equivalent examination is eligible to seek admission to the 1st year of the 3-year (Six Semester) B.A/ B.Sc. / B.Com (Honours & General) Course of Studies under Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) provided he/she need to have passed mandatorily in English having full marks not being less than 100. However, no candidate shall be allowed for admission after a lapse of more than 5 years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination of recognized regular course of study. Year of Passing must not be before 2015. Students who have passed the previous qualifying examination before 2020, got admitted under University of Calcutta and appeared for University Examinations are not eligible to apply.

Explanation: The year of Admission shall not be taken into account while calculating five years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination.

2. If adequate number of Scheduled Tribe candidates is not available, remaining seats shall be made available to Scheduled Caste candidates first. If adequate number of Scheduled Caste Candidates is not available, remaining seats shall be made available to Scheduled Tribe candidates first. If adequate number of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe candidates are not available to fill in the earmarked seats, the appropriate Authority of the College may consider filling up of such seats with General Category Candidates, provided the college has obtained the required approval from the appropriate Authority of the Government.

- 1. Admission to B.A./B.Sc./B.Com.(Hons.&Gen.) will take place through *ON-LINE* in the specified dates to be notified on the College Website.
- 2. The college authority reserves the right to take all decisions regarding admission and that is final and binding.
- 3. All admissions are subject to the approval of the University of Calcutta by the way of registration.
- 4. Documents (i.e. Marksheet, Admit Card, Caste Certificate, School Leaving Certificate etc.) will be verified before the commencement of 1st Semester class after Admission. If any document found to be wrong, the admission is liable to be cancelled and admission fees will be refunded by proper Application.
