- 1) Only those Students who studied under West Bengal Council of H.S. Education / C.B.S.E/I.S.C/National Institute of Open Schooling / Rabindra Mukta Vidyalayaand other recognized Boards as approved by University of Calcutta are eligible to fill up the application form directly from the College Website.

Admission Qualifications

1. A candidate who has passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) or its equivalent examination is eligible to seek admission to the 1st year of the 3-year (Six Semester)B.A/B.Sc./B.Com (Honours& General) Course of Studies under Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) provided he/she need to have passed mandatorily in English having full marks not being less than 100. However, no candidate shall be allowed for admission after a lapse of more than 5 years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination of recognized regular course of study. Year of Passing must not be before 2016. Students who have passed the previous qualifying examinationbefore2021, got admitted under University of Calcutta and appeared for University Examinations <u>are not eligible to apply</u>.

Explanation: The year of Admission shall not be taken into account while calculating five years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination.

2. If adequate number of Scheduled Tribe candidates is not available, remaining seats shall be made available to Scheduled Caste candidates first. If adequate number of Scheduled Caste Candidates is not available, remaining seats shall be made available to Scheduled Tribe candidates first. If adequate number of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe candidates are not available to fill in the earmarked seats, the appropriate Authority of the College may consider filling up of such seats with General Category Candidates, provided the college has obtained the required approval from the appropriate Authority of the Government.
